CBAS Revised Draft Individual Plan of Care (IPC) and Quality Strategy – Now Posted on CDA Website for Review and Comment

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) and the California Department of Aging (CDA) are pleased to announce that the revised Draft CBAS IPC, the standardized *CBAS Participation Agreement* (which is a companion document to the IPC), and the *CBAS Quality Assurance and Improvement Strategy (CBAS Quality Strategy)* are now posted on CDA's website for review and comment. Comments will be accepted through Friday, September 30, 2016 (close of business). Comments on all documents may be submitted via online surveys posted on [CDA's website](#).

Both the revised Draft IPC and the *CBAS Quality Strategy* are products of an extensive stakeholder workgroup process that began in July 2015. Workgroup members included CBAS providers and representatives, managed care plan representatives, and advocates.
